House Wines - White

Norte Chico Sauvignon Blanc, *Central Valley, Chile*

Great glass of 'zingy' dry white with the aroma & taste of freshly picked gooseberries.

Terralis Torrentés Chardonnay, *Mendoza, Argentina*

This starts with zingy punch moving on to a round satisfying palate and finish with a burst of lime zest.

Porter Mill Station Chenin Blanc, *South Africa*

Crisp & fresh just as if biting into a fresh apple.

House Wines – Red

Norte Chico Merlot, *Central Valley, Chile*

Deliciously fruity, this is a medium bodied, having aromas of ripe berries & a touch of chocolate.

Rolleston Vale Shiraz Cabernet, *South East Australia*

Rich & bold in colour with a spicy fruit filled nose then flavours of mixed berries, brambles & licorice.

Red Wines

William's Well Reserve Shiraz, *South Eastern Australia*

Dark purple, ripe & rich, this is spicy, packed with fruitcake aroma & the taste of brambles & liquorice.

Explorer Pinot Noir, *Central Valley, Chile*

With the classic Burgundy variety & a skilled winemaker, its earthy characteristics are revealed as you enjoy it.

The Ruins Pinotage, *Robertson, South Africa*

Robust & earthy & from organically grown fruit this has intense red & black cherries, white spice & silky tannins.

Prunatelli Chianti Rufina, *Tuscany, Italy*

Traditionally dusky with flavours of bitter chocolate & raisins with a deep, dry tannic finish. £ 16.95

Rioja Urbina Crianza, *Cuzcurrita, Rioja Alta, Spain*

The epitome of Spain, evocative rich aromas of leather & spices with cigar boxes, cedar wood & Vanilla.

Château des Antonins, *Bordeaux Supérieur, France*

Traditional blend with blackcurrants from Cabernet & slightly herbal berry fruit from Merlot – classic claret.

Night Harvest White Zinfandel, *California*
